


Entrepreneur - Endeavor Touch Points


While 1-on-1 mentoring sessions with Endeavor mentors and board members were the most requested, webinars and group mentoring allowed our regional experts to dig deeper into individual issues and help our entrepreneurs identify and troubleshoot urgent problems. Endeavor APAC also received a large outpouring of support from other entrepreneurs in our network, which resulted in a series of successful peer-to-peer learning sessions. Public sessions provided a forum for multiple Endeavor offices and the extended Endeavor network to come together to share concerns, as well as offer support and ideas to help other ecosystem players manage the crisis.


We're very appreciative of the support Endeavor has given us, especially during the crisis, and looking forward to more support as we go through different types of challenges in many years to come.
